Ken, as Kelan's sponsor, attended the new member orientation and introduced some basic mentoring programs from LCI and Proud Lion that will help Kelan and Frances get acclimated to the club.

Several Hawaii Kai Lions attended District Governor Angie Haramoto's 1st Cabinet meeting at Lanikila Senior center. Highlight of the meeting was the charter of the Hawaii Cyber Club and installation of the club President Peggy Oyama and officers. The club has 35 charter members and 12 associate members.

Hawaii Kai Lions donated \$1,000 to the Kaiser High School Girls Soccer team for uniforms and equipment.
